Two important Tikkun Olam projects are taking place in JUNE

1) **Help prepare Hero Packs for pediatric patients.** We are working with the organization: Holiday Heroes. The packs include toys, games, art projects and other things to keep children of all ages engaged while in Chicago area hospitals.

2) **In conjunction with STOCK THE SHELVES,** we need your help to collect: Diapers (#1-5) and feminine hygiene products (no tampons) that government aid does not cover for refugees and asylum seekers who have been settled in the Rogers Park area. They are from countries like Afghanistan and Sudan who haven't made front page news since October, but are still war-torn and food insecure. This event will be a great opportunity to meet others from the BHBE community as well as congregants from Winnetka Covenant Church (located in Wilmette) while doing mitzvah work together. **Join us and be part of the Tikkun Olam Team - Building Community at BHBE. 3) **And a REMINDER to support the Israel front...** We also recommend looking into the **BAYIT BRIGADE**, an organization started to support "lone soldiers" (those who volunteer for the Israeli army who have no family living in Israel).
